2. COMPOSITION. INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Aqueous seaweed extract with added ferric sulphate.

3. HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

Irritant. Risk of serious damage to eyes. Harmful if swallowed, may cause systemic damage and gastrointestinal irritation

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Eyes: Contact with eyes may cause severe irritation. Irrigate with copious amounts of eyewash or clean water for 10 minutes minimum. If symptoms persist, seek medical attention.

Skin: Contact with skin, particularly if broken, may cause irritation. Rinse immediately with copious amounts of fresh water. If symptoms persist, seek medical attention.

Inhalation: In the event of inhalation remove from source of inhalation, keep warm and at rest until any symptoms desist. If symptoms persist, seek medical attention. Inhalation may cause irritation of respiratory tract.

Ingestion: May cause gastro-intestinal irritation. Do not induce vomiting. Irrigate mouth with copious amounts of water. Do not give anything to drink. If vomiting occurs place the patient in the recovery position. If symptoms persist, seek medical attention.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Extinguishing Media: Product is not flammable. Use extinguishers suited to surrounding fire conditions.

Special Fire Fighting: Wear self contained breathing apparatus. Material will support combustion.

Fire Decomposition: May release toxic fumes of sulphur dioxide.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Precautions: Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Provide an eyewash station.

Spillage ; Evacuate area. Contain and absorb with sand, earth or other inert material. Sweep up and place waste in sealed containers. Contact Local Authority for controlled waste disposal. Notify Environment Agency immediately if large spillage enters drains, sewers or water courses.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Usage Precautions: Wear full overall protective clothing, goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and boots.

Storage Precautions: Keep sealed in original containers. Store in a dry frost-free place above two degrees Celsius.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS AND PERSONAL PROTECTION

Engineering Controls: Apply COSHH assessment according to standard (OES) EH 40/94.

Exposure Limits: 1 mg/m³ Fe 8h TWA

Protective Equipment: Wear full protective overall clothing.

Hands and feet: Wear PVC or rubber gloves and boots.

Eyes and Face: Wear face shield or goggles to BS 2092.

Respiration: Wear type approved dust mask.

Stability: Stable in normal ambient conditions.
