GENERAL INFORMATION

Spraying Oil is a thick white emulsion of paraffin distillates and surfactants which readily mixes with water. It is recommended for the control of red spider mites, mealy bugs and scale insects, pests which are usually difficult to control.

Spraying Oil works on red spider mites by both blocking their breathing pores and by making the leaf surfaces inhospitable to migrating mites. Scale insects and mealy bugs cannot tolerate the penetrating solvent and surfactant properties of Spraying Oil and they will not attach themselves to, or invade treated leaf surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Recommended crops

Spraying Oil can be used on all edible and all non-edible crops, both protected and outdoor. Apply when crops are dormant or on plants with a known tolerance to Spraying Oil. Because of the large number of varieties and species grown, varietal susceptibility should be checked by treating a small area/number of plants in the first instance.

Pests controlled

Red spider mite, scale insects and mealy bugs.

Mixing

Stir the contents of the pail thoroughly. Mix the quantity required for immediate use to a thin cream with water and add to the remainder of the water whilst agitating.

Rate of use

1 part Spraying Oil to 100 parts of water. On young plants with tender foliage use 1 part Spraying Oil to 200 parts of water.

Application

Apply with a fine nozzle and wet plants thoroughly, particularly the undersides of the leaves. Repeat throughout the season as necessary. Spray under quick-drying conditions and when using under protection do not apply in bright sunshine unless the glass is well shaded.

Cautions

If mineral oils are used in conjunction with certain pesticides, serious crop damage may result. Growers who mix Spraying Oil with other pesticides are strongly advised to first spray a few plants to test for crop tolerance before treating larger areas.

DO NOT tank-mix Spraying Oil with sulphur sprays or Rovral WG, or use these materials within 28 days of applying SPRAYING OIL.

Treat vines only before flowering.

Do not spray crops suffering from drought stress.
